### Delaware Division of Corporations Resumes Operations

**Dover, DE (September 8, 2015)** – The Delaware Division of Corporations has resumed operations after completing a major computer system conversion over Labor Day weekend.

The completely revamped Delaware Corporation Information System (DCIS) replaces the existing DCIS system which has been used since 1989. This upgrade enables the State and its network of authorized online registered agents to offer expanded and improved products and services to customers.

More than 1.1 million active business entities worldwide are incorporated in Delaware including 66 percent of Fortune 500 firms. The new DCIS is a customized system providing a long-term platform for expanded flexibility and functionality for the Division's customers and employees, and will allow global customers to access information regarding corporations more quickly and efficiently.

The Division will offer the following operating hours (subject to change) during the next two weeks to allow for continued system maintenance and troubleshooting:

- **September 8 through September 11** – 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. All 1 hour, 2 hour and same day submissions must be received by 1 p.m. 24 hour and all other submissions are due by 5 p.m.
- **September 14 through September 18** – 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. All 1 hour and 2 hour submissions must be received by 5 p.m. All other expedited cut-off times will return to normal (same day 2 p.m. and 24 hour 7 p.m.) and all other submissions are due by 8 p.m.
