Before the Certificate can be filed, all taxes due the State at the time the corporation became forfeited must be paid. Please contact the Franchise Tax Section prior to filing this document to determine the franchise taxes due. Please make your checks payable to “Delaware Secretary of State”.

For the convenience of processing your order in a timely manner, please include a cover letter with your name, address and telephone/fax number to enable us to contact you if necessary. Please make sure you complete all information requested on this form. It is important that the execution be legible, we request that you print or type your name under the signature line.
